Explore the museum's newest exhibit Powerful You. Learn how your body's system works together so you can stay physically fit and ready to act in any situation.

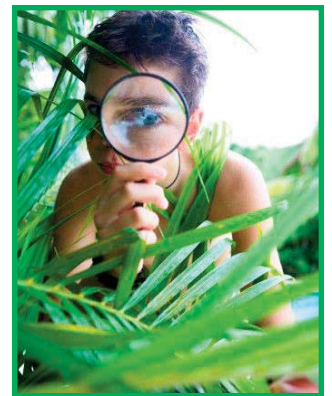
## Aviation\*
